MONDAY, FEBRUARY 19th, 1940.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, February 19th, 1940, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

The minutes of January 31st, 1940, were read and there being no objection to the sale, motion was made by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that they stand approved as read. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report of the condition at the County Farm filed by A. F. Ezzell, Livestock and Meat Inspector, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by the New Hope Baptist Church covering Lots 11 and 12, Block 12, Greenwood Addition to Tulsa, for the years 1936 to 1939, Inc., be and the same is hereby approved, upon the recommendation of the County Attorney, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed and directed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, for the District Court for the month of January, 1940, be and the same is hereby approved and filed.
