AND WHEREAS, Form #0-596, proposing work in addition to projects heretofore approved and under construction, is now being presented to Works Progress Administration

AND WHEREAS, in said Project Statements, it is provided, amond other provisions, in the Federal Non Labor items, for the purchase of Gasoline, Motor Oil, and Diesel Oil, and in the Sponsor Non Labor items, provision is made for the sponsor to purchase 490000 gallons of Road Oil, which provision was expressly set up to provide a saving of Four Cents per gallon, appregating a saving of \$3,480.00 in the estimated cost of the project,

NOW, THEREFORE, because of the provision respecting purchase of the items mentioned above and the savings that will accrue to the sponsor by reason thereof, Tulsa County binds itself to carry out the provision made in Sponsor's Proposal for the furnishing of, and up to the gallonage specified, of SC2 Road Oil, with or without "Spot Test" at Sponsor's option.
