Sheriff Thurman noted that a meeting needs to be set up with the Police Commissioner and the Chief of Police, as well as the District Attorney and the Presiding Judge, concerning reimbursement from the City of Tulsa for one-half of the cost of the expansion of the program.

Edwards reported that he is working with the other elected officials and division directors regarding smoking/nonsmoking areas and will report again at the next Management Conference.

Motion by Selph, seconded by Harris, to approve a policy on illegal possession or use of drugs, intoxicants, weapons, explosives and other dangerous items. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Selph, yes; Rice, yes. Motion carried.

The Board directed Tallent to present the above policy and the recently-adopted policy on safety to the Budget Board.


Motion by Harris, seconded by Rice, to approve travel for Clayton Edwards to Oklahoma City, Association of County Commissioners' meeting, at an approximate cost of \$150. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Selph, yes; Rice, yes. Motion carried. (Clerk's Misc. File No. 119901)
