

Dear Sir:-

I am in receipt of a letter from the Muskogee office enclosing photographic copy of report of Engineer H.K. Palmer relative to the assessments against the restricted Indians on account of the Fry Drainage District in Tulsa County. They recommend payment of the assessments against the following lands providing you will waive the interest on same, to-wit:

They think, however, that the other land assessed against restricted Indians is not benefitted in any way and that the land not benefitted should not be assessed. They, also, insist on quick action as this must be submitted to the Washington office not later than November 10th. so please let me have your answer as soon as possible as it always takes a little time to submit these matters to the Washington office.
