In the matter of the application of the OKLAHOMA NATURAL GAS COMPANY for permission to construct pipe lines along certain highways, and after consideration the following order was made:

IN RE application of OKLAHOMA NATURAL GAS COMPANY, a corporation, of Tulsa Oklahoma, to construct pipe lines along and under public highways of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning at a point approximately five (5) feet North and Five (5) feet East of the center of Section 23, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and running thence in an Easterly direction a distance of twelve hundred (1200) feet to a point approximately twenty (20) feet North of the East and West Center line of said Section 23; thence East a distance of fourteen Hundred Forty Eight (1448) feet to a point approximately twenty (20) feet North of the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 23; and running thence in a Northerly direction into the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Twp 19 N., Rge., 12, East, to plant of Oklahoma Power Company; thereby being along the East and West highway which follows the East and West Half Section line of said section 23, Twp 19 N., Rge. 12 East to be known as "Service Lines City of Tulsa to Oklahoma Power Company" an eigh inch (8") gas pipe line.

Now, on this 30th day of March, A.D 1925, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma held in compliance with and according to law, the application of Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma for the right to put down, construct and operate its eight inch gas pipe line known as "Service Lines, City of Tulsa to Oklahoma Power Company", along and under the above specified public highways of Tulsa County Okla., which application is in writing and sets forth that it is necessary for the purpose of further advancing the business of said company in the purchasing producing, marketing, transporting and conveying of natural gas as in said petition stated, to lay, construct, operate and maintain said pipe line along and under the specified public highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, comes on to be considered and said Board after hearing said application and considering same
