The improvements contemplated it appears were not provided for, when advertisements for bids for the work which is now in progress in the immediate vicinity of these culverts was made, and because of unforseen circumstances, the inclusion of the construction of the culverts in question was not included in the contract made and entered into pursuant to said advertisement.

In this circumstance, I find no precedent for, though I understand that in identical circumstances, the Board has used its discretion, and has considered the construction such as is contemplated, a part of the original plans and specifications; this being true, and in view of the substantial benefit to Tulsa County, by reason of the equipment, tools, etc., being now practically at the point of location, and the lack of directing authority, the Board might in this case properly exercise its discretion, and consider the culverts in question as part and parcel of the original improvements.
