APPLICATION RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION NO. 38102

A resolution authorizing the Architect to file an application to the United States of America Through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for a grant to aid in financing the construction of a new courthouse, and designating William H. Wolaver, Architect to furnish such information as the Government may request.

Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners:

Section 1. That William H. Wolaver, be, and he is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners to the United States of America for a grant to aid in financing the construction of a new County Courthouse.

Section 2. That William H. Wolaver, Architect, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be file.
