The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday,
June 5th, 1939, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H.

Upon roll c all, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Chairman be authorized and instructed to issue a quit claim deed to Industrial Investment Company covering Lot 7, Block 6, North Side Addition to Tulsa, for the reason that said property was sold to Tulsa County in error; all delinquent taxes having been paid prior to the date of the resalc. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
