Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that upon the recommendation of the Tulsa County Medical Society, the hospitalization of Tulsa County be placed with the private hospitals on a flat rate per day and that the rate be set at \$3.25 per day including all expenses (Laboratory, x-ray, drugs and prescriptions) and that the hospital be permitted to charge \$1.00 additional per day for babies in connection with O.B. cases; this rate effective as of February 21st, 1940. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, A ye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.
