ORDER OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
AFTER RECEIVING VIEWERS' REPORT.

In the matter of Drain or Improvement No.2,petitioned for by John Reynolds, et al. )	Office of County Clerk, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, this 6th day of Nov. 1911.	Order Drain # 2.
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This day the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met in regular session. The report of the viewers in the above entitled matter having been filed as required by law, it is hereby ordered that the 4th day of December, 1911, be and same is hereby fixed as the day and date for hearing the petition and report of the viewers thereon. And it is hereby ordered that notice be given for two weeks in the Tulsa Democrat, a weekly newspaper printed and of general circulation in this County, of the pendency of said petition, the appointment and report of the viewers, the place of beginning, route and terminus of said proposed drain or improvement, and the time when the petition and report thereon by the viewers will be heard. Said notice shall notify any person interested in land which will be affected by said proposed drain or improvement that he may file in the office of the County Clerk on or before the day set for the hearing of the report of the viewers a written remonstrance and objection against the same, setting forth his grievance. Said publication must appear in said newspaper at least two weeks and the date of the last publication shall be at least ten days before the day and date set for the hearing thereon.
