together with all improvements thereon, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

It is understood that the premises hereby conveyed are to be used as and for a railroad right of way and all other purposes incidental to railroad uses, and if and when abandoned for such purposes, the same shall revert to the party of the first part. In the event of an abandonment, the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, shall have the right, within a reasonable time, to take up and remove all materials entering into the construction of the track upon the within described premises.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said described premises unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, forever, free clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and incumbrances of whatsoever nature.
