Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, ~~that~~ the Board of County Commissioner approve a change of plan on Project 2-A covering the surfacing and improving of the extension of McKinley Ave. from the North city limits ^{of Sand Springs} to the Osage County Line, and that a 3" dense type Asphaltic concrete base material be installed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, the Board of County Commissioners approve a change of plan on Project 2-B covering the surfacing and improving of the North Sand Springs road from paving in place at Bruner Hill to paving in place on McKinley Ave. at Sand Springs, and that a 3" dense type Asphaltic base material be installed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.


