Pursuant to recess heretofore taken the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman, Curtis Greer and Robt. L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, to approve the following Resolution. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Douglas Aircraft Company, Inc., has made a written request for permission to erect a railing or series of posts opposite the West entrance of the Modification Center on North Thirty-sixth Street, adjacent to the Municipal Airport, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that said accident prevention measure is needful at said location and that the request should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the Douglas Aircraft Company, Inc., be and it is hereby permitted at its expense, to erect a railing or series of posts opposite the West entrance of the Modification Center on North Thirty-sixth Street, adjacent to the Municipal Airport, Tulsa, Oklahoma.
