MONDAY FEBRUARY 21ST, 1944

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M., with the following members present: Curtis Greer and Robt. L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk. J. B. Gray, Chairman absent.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, that Curtis Greer act as Chairman during the absence of J. B. Gray, Chairman. Seconded by Commissioner Greer. Motion carried.

Curtis Greer, Acting Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, to appoint Jud Wasson, as Truck Driver in the Highway Department, District No. 3, at a salary of \$6.00 per day, effective as of February 9, 1944. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, to appoint Bill Dalton, as Grader Operator in Highway Department, District No. 2, at a salary of \$170.00 per month, effective February 22, 1944. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the following order be approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

ORDER OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RELATING TO SALE OF COUNTY PROPERTY ACQUIRED AT RE-SALE

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has presented to this Board the foregoing transcript of all his proceedings in said sale, with all papers and proofs relating to said sale, for the approval of this Board of County Commissioners, and

This Board of County Commissioners being convened in the office of the County Clerk of said County and State on the date hereinafter set forth,

WE HAVE CAREFULLY EXAMINED said transcript and proceedings, and find:

1. That the sale of Lot Five (5) Block Four (4) Exposition Heights Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma to M. K. Jones for a consideration of \$700.00 was properly advertised and fairly conducted and the amount of the sale is deemed a fair price.

THEREFORE, so finding, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, does hereby order and direct that the foregoing sale be approved; and the Chairman of said Board of County Commissioners is hereby ordered and directed to EXECUTE A DEED conveying the foregoing described property to M. K. Jones in as full and complete a manner as the County is authorized to convey it; and the County Treasurer is ordered and directed, upon the execution of said Deed to pay into the proper funds and accounts the moneys heretofore received by him in consideration thereof.
