Lou Henry of the Welfare Department of Tulsa County got in touch with the proper authorities in Greer County and arranged for their return but they refused to go stating that they intended to stay in Tulsa County. Since that time a number of efforts have been made to get this family to return to their legal residence, and as late as April 9th, 1935, the Welfare Department received a telegram from Mrs. Epperson of Greer County advising that the family be returned to Greer County and that they would put Mr. Anderson to work on the FERA immediately. Therefore, the County Commissioners of Tulsa County feel that under the circustances this family is a responsibility of Greer County and should be returned as Mr. Anderson is perfectly able to work and not considered on the unemployable list or a charge of Tulsa County. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried.

O R D R R

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of Jounty Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to J. H. CARTER of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Ninety-Eight and 25/100 dollars (\$98.25) the following described land:

AND WHEREAS, the sale of said land by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 97 of the compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1917, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by at tax resale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the West Tulsa News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treasurer would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of deed therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other person having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said land, and the County of Tulsa has no need for said land for any purpose required by law whatsoever.

NOW, THEREFORE, the B:ard of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled a and pursuant to the aforesaid statutes of the State of Oklahoma, hereby approve the sale of said property so made by the County Treasurer to J. H. CARTER for a consideration of \$98.25, and it is hereby ordered that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners execute to J. H. CARTER a deed conveying to him all the right, title and interest of the County of Tulsa, State of (klahoma, in and to said property, and the County Clerk of Tulsa County is hereby directed to attest with his signature and attach the seal of his office.
