The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, The Chairman of the Board ordered the resolution read as follows, to-wit:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Tulsa County owns one 1934 Oldsmobile Sedan, Motor No. L36683, the Oklahoma License No. 11019, and

WHEREAS, said automobile not being in service by reason of use, age, wear and tear is no longer of value in operation and the expense in upkeep and maintenance is no longer justified, and

WHEREAS, recommendation having been made by the County Engineer that the above described automobile be junked or otherwise disposed of and not be registered under the Motor Vehicle Law for the year 1931 for the reasons above stated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the above described automobile is by this Board declared to be of no further value except as junk and it is hereby ordered that same no longer be offered for registration under the Motor Vehicle Registration Law of Oklahoma.
