RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa County Sinking Fund is overdrawn and it is necessary that there be funds supplied on or before July 1, 1932, with which to pay interest coupons and bonded indebtedness heretofore issued by the County for the construction of hard surfaced roads.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that there being a surplus in the County Highway Fund that the County Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed pursuant to Chapt.66 Art 8, Session Laws 1931, Page 250, to transfer eight (8%) per cent of income and revenue derived during this fiscal year by Tulsa County from Automobile Tax which amounts to \$23,539.19, and Five (5%) per cent of income and revenues derived during this fiscal year by Tulsa County from Gasoline Excise Tax which amounts to \$5,151.03 to the County Sinking Fund to be used in the payment of the interest and principle of bonds heretofore issued by Tulsa County for the construction of hard surfaced roads in said County the amount so transferred aggregating \$28,690.20.
