Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer that a recess be taken until 2:00 o'clock P. M.

AFTER RECESS 2;00 o'clock P. M.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock +. M. with all members present and presiding as before.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the date of September 3, 1946, be set for hearing of any and all protests and objections to the Maintenance and Operation Budget for Tulsa County Drainage District #12, in the amount of \$52,500.00 filed by Richard Erwin, Commissioner for the District; and that the County Clerk be ordered and directed to give four weeks publication notice of such hearing in the Sand Springs Leader, as required by law. Upon rdl call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bail ey, that the following Resolution be and the same is hereby adopted; to-wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, THE OKIAHOMA GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, under date of July 22nd, 1946, has made application for the use of certain highways of Tulsa County, for the purpose of transmitting and selling electricity for light, heat and power purposes, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said Company is entitled under the laws to use the said highways for such purposes, and whereas, it appears that the use of such highways will not interfere with, or impede traffic and that such service is at this time demanded by customers to be served by said line.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that we, the Board of County Commissioners, in regular meeting, do hereby give our consent to the use of the following high-ways in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, by the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, its successors and assigns, for the purpose of transmitting and selling electric current, said highway being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Section 23, (T17N-R13E) and extending south a distance of one mile between Sections 22 and 23, thence east and west a distance of two miles between Sections 23, 26 and Sections 27 and 22. Also commencing at the northeast corner of Section 31 (T17N-R14E) and extending south a distance of one mile between Sections 31 and 32. Also commencing at the north east corner of Section 21 (T17N-R14E) and extending east a distance of two miles
