

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the salary of Dr. L. C. Presson be reduced from \$300.00 to \$185.00 per month, and that he be given a car allowance of \$95.00 per month, to become effective as of January 1, 1950. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the Quit Claim Deed between John Couch, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and Record Owners of East Turley Addition covering the following described land: The Northwest quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Six (6) Township Twenty(20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East less a tract of land described as follows: Beginning 320 feet south of the NW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, Township 20 North, Range 13 East, thence east parallel with the northline of said 40 acres, a distance of 590 feet, thence south parallel with the west line of said 40 acres a distance of 445 feet, thence west parallel with the north line of said 40 acres a distance of 590 feet; thence north along the west line of said 40 acres a distance of 445 feet to the point of beginning.

This quit claim deed is given for the purpose of releasing any claim Tulsa County may have acquired by County Tax Deed issued by the Treasurer of Tulsa County and recorded in Book 1322, page 645 of the records of the Register of Deeds in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

The Minutes of the meetings of the Board of County Commissioners from June 30, 1949 through December 23, 1949, were read. There being one correction made to same, motion was made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the minutes stand approved as read and corrected. Upon roll call, motion carried.
