MONDAY, APRIL 21st, 1941.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, April 21st, 1941, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the Depository Agreement between the National Bank of Tulsa and the Board of County Commissioners in the amount of \$100,000, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

AUTHORITY TO RELEASE SECURITIES

We, the undersigned Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, being in legal meeting convened, have given due consideration to the demand of the National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and authorized depository of said County, and the verification of the accounts of said County with said depository Bank as made by the County Treasurer herein, and we find such withdrawal will leave the accounts of the County adequately secured within the sum of \$500,000.00, and therefore we do hereby direct and command that the specific securities identified by the within and foregoing detailed list in the aggregate of \$100,000.00 be released by the County Treasurer and the Custodian of said securities to the Owner Bank herein or on his order, immediately and without delay.
