Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the agreement made between R. M. Black, Architect, and the Board of County Commissioners and Oliver Hodge, County Superintendent, on the erection of a one three-car bus garage for Separate Depdent School District 69, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and the same is approved upon the recommendation of Oliver Hodge, County Superintendent, and the Chairman is hereby directed and instructed to sign said agreement. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the rental free contract with the N.Y.A., be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign said contract. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$26,670.80, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby directed to sign said application and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The minutes of April 7th and 8th were read and there being no objection to the same, motion was made by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that they stand approved as read. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that a recess be taken until Monday, May 5th, 1941, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
