MONDAY, MARCH 18th, 1940.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, March 18th, 1940, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with the following members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley, member. Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Lincoln Sallee, member, absent.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, for the District Court for the month of February, 1940, be and the same is hereby approved and filed. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Clyde L. Sears, covering real-estate for the year 1939, and approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that \$10.00 per month be granted toward the payment of rent of a sewing room at Bixby as of March 1st, 1940. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye. Motion carried.

Upon motion duly made by Commissioner Shepard, seconded by Commissioner Morley, the bond of Robert F. Wise, Clerk of Water Improvement District No. 10 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, with Standard Accident Insurance Company as surety which is this date presented, is approved and the Chairman of this Board is directed to endorse his approval thereon and the said bond is ordered filed.
