

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Abstractor's Bond filed by J. Lacy Ballenger Abstract Company in the amount of \$5,000.00 and made by the Continental Casualty Company for a period from July 31, 1946 to July 31, 1947, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the following bids submitted by the Standard Paving Company and Layman and Company on Projects 2-D and 2-G, be turned over to the County Engineer for compilation and report. On Project 2-D for the improvement of Sky Line Road from 41st paving in place to paving in place South of U. S. 64,

Standard Paving Company's Bid in the amount of \$62,822.80, accompanied by Certified Check drawn on the National Bank of Tulsa in the amount of \$3,300.00, and

Layman and Company's Bid in the amount of \$64,745.30, accompanied by a Certified Check drawn on the National Bank of Tulsa in the amount of \$3,000.00, and

on Project 2-G for the improvement of the Sand Springs By-pass from U. S. 64 to Wekiwa Road,

Standard Paving Company's Bid in the amount of \$2,195.00, accompanied by Certified Bid Check drawn on the National Bank of Tulsa in the amount of \$110.00, and

Layman and Company's Bid in the amount of 2,363.50, accompanied by a Bid Check drawn on the National Bank of Tulsa in the amount of \$110.00.

Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Contract, statutory and Performance Bonds with Layman and Company, covering the surfacing and improving of 21st Street from Memorial to 116th East Avenue, Project 3-B, be and the same are hereby approve, and the Chairman be and hereby is authorized to sign same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that Layman and Company, low bidder, be awarded the contract covering the surfacing and improving of Lynn Lane Road from 11th Street to 51st Street, a distance of 3.996 miles, for a total amount of \$77,102.60. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Project No. 3-C.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the plans and specifications covering the improving of 116th Street North, and 116th Avenue East from U. S. 75 and 166th Street North to U. S. 75 and 116th Avenue East, a distance of 4.039 miles, be and the same are hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed and authorized to advertise for Bids to be received until 9:00 o'clock A. M., Monday, August 5, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
