for the purpose of constructing, developing, operating and maintaining an airplane bomber assembly plant, together with all accessory buildings, construction, aprons and runways in connection therewith, as a military and national defense project.

Section 2. That the United States of America be and it is hereby granted the right to go into and take immediate exclusive and permanent possession of the above described County roads and highways for the uses and purposes above set out.

Section 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, by reason whereof this Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
