Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the claim presented by J. L. Ramsey, Seminole, Oklahoma, dated July 26, 1946 in the amount of \$500.00, covering damages sustained by Tulsa County Highway employees in appropriating for road purposes and grading the same, a tract of land 25 ft. wide and 292 ft. long off the Easterly side of Lots 1: and 2 in Block 1, Clifton Heights Addition to Red Fork. Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as claimed by Mr. Ramsey, be and the same is hereby disallowed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the report filed by Cameron Cline, Court Clerk, for the District Court Division for the month of June, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Standard Paving Company, low bidder, be awarded the contract for the improving Sky Line Road from the paving in place on West 41st Street, West and North to the Paving in Place, South of U.S. 64 on the Sapulpa-Sand Springs Highway, for a total amount of \$62,822.80, known as Project 2-D. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Standard Paving Company, the Low Bidder, be awarded the contract for the improving of the Sand Springs By-Pass from U. S. Highway #64, North to the Wekiwa Road, in the amount of \$2,195.00, known as project No. 2-G. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Contract, Statutory and Performance Bonds on Project No. 3-C, which covers the surfacing and improving of Lynn Lane Road from 11th Street to 51st Street, a distance of 3.996 miles, be and the same are hereby approved, and the Chairman be and hereby is authorized to sign same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that a recess be taken until Monday, August 5, 1946, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock a. m. Motion carried.
