property, and that proceeds from said sale, disregarding said taxes are insufficient to pay the amount due on said note.

WHEREFORE, Movant prays that all the taxes assessed for the years 1919, 1921 1922, 1923 and 1924 be cancelled, stricken and forever charged off.
