

assessments bore to to total and that the amountof each re-assessment against each lot or tract of land in dollars and cents is and shall be as shown by Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That Installment No.10 of the original assessment to be assessed and paid during the fiscal year 1932-33 be hereby deferred and postponed until the fiscal year 1934-35. This deferment of this instalment shall in no way be construed to release any of the propertynor lands in said District from the originallassessment as levied.

SECTION 3. That certain of the lands and property included in said Drainage District and which are re-assessed herein are owned by the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and that the County Attorney shall proceed to file suit against said City of Tulsa to collect as provided by law, the re-assessments herein levied.

SECTION 4. That the term "re-assessment" wherever used herein shall mean or be synonymous with the phrase "additional assessment".

SECTION 5. That if any of the original assessments hot heretofore paid shall be paid together with all of the re-assessments herein levied, so as to create any surplus over and above the amount necessary to pay and satisfythe judgment above referred to, that such excess in funds shall be used for the maintenance of the drainage ditches.

SECTION 6. That it is necessary and desirable that sufficient funds be rais ed at the earliest opportunity to pay and retire the judgment aforesaid, and to provide for funds with which to maintain proper drainage ditches and to that end that this resolution and order shall become operative immediately; wherefore, an emergency ishereby declared to exist and this Resolution and Order shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its spassage and approval.
