Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the following Resolution be adopted: (Project No. S-321 (2))

WHEREAS, The State Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma has agreed to submit to the Federal Works Agency, Public Roads Administration, a project for the improvement of 4.984 miles of 6" Dense Graded Gravel Base Course and Double Bituminous Surface Course. Beginning 4 Miles South of Bixby and Extending Southwest, with funds apportioned the State under the Federal Highway Act as amended and supplemented, and

WHEREAS, The County of Tulsa, Oklahoma desires that such improvement be made and does agree to maintain said highway in a manner satisfactory to the State Highway Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma after its improvement, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of said County be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and execute a contract and agreement with said State Highway Commission carrying out the purposes of this resolution.

Adopted this 16 day of February, 1948 by the unanimous vote of said Board of County Commissioners.
