## MONDAY, JUNE 26th, 1939.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by R. W. Burkhart covering personal property for the years 1926 to 1933, Inc., be and the same is hereby denied. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Wm. O. Bohnefeld covering personal property for the years 1931-1932 and 1933, be and the same is hereby approved for a 70% reduction and the County Clerk is directed to issue a certificate of error covering same, provided, however, that the certificate of error shall not be issued until the expiration of twenty days from the date of this order and, provided further, that said certificate of error shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said twenty days until the issue of said protest is determined. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a quit claim deed to Helen DeSmith covering Lot 3, Block 7, Midway Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the reason that said property was sold in error to Tulsa County; said taxes having been paid prior to the date of the resale. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a quit claim deed to J. H. Watson covering Lot 8, Block 6, Garden City Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the reason that said property was sold in error; said property owner was allowed homestead exemption for the year 1939. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried,
