The following Resolution was offered by Mr. W L North.

#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is made to appear to this Board by Byron Kirkpatrick, County Attorney, that heretofore, to-wit: October 14th. 1924, in a certain cause then pending in the District Court wherein the State of Oklahoma was Plaintiff and Jack Smith, JS and E I Cue were Defendants, said cause being numbered 25145, the State of Oklahoma by consideration of the Court recovered a judgment against JS Cue for the sum of One thousand Dollars, together with interest thereon and costs, and

WHEREAS, the cause of action above mentioned arose and had its origin by reason of the forfeiture of a certain criminal appearance bond signed by said J S Cue as Surety in said cause, and the judgment so recovered is a lien upon the real property shheduled by said J S Cue and that said property so scheduled constituted all of the property real and personal now owned or possessed by said J S Cue, and

WHEREAS, said J S Cue is upwards of eighty years of age; is sick and infirm, and has heretofore made arrangements with the Mowbray Undertaking Company, representing by M. r. Manning, whereby said Undertaking Company agreed to bury said J S Cue, but to carry out said arrangement it becomes necessary to sell and dispose of the real estate scheduled upon said appearance bond and which is now subject to the lien of the judgment of the State of Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, it appears that Defendant, Jack Smith, was on the 1st. day of December, 1924, conveyed and committed in the State Penitentiary at McAlester, and has now served the full sentence imposed upon him, and has been discharged from said institution, and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney recommends that a satisfaction of said judgment the ends of justice will have been satisfied, said J S Cue will be enabled thereby to carry out the agreement by him made with said Mowbray Undertaking Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is hereby directed and instructed upon the payment of the costs occasioned by said proceeding to enter a satisfaction in full as against J S Cue, upon the judgment docket of the District Court and these presents will be his authority so to do.
