

that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point within the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 21, North, Range 13, East and running thence North to the Northeasterly part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 10, thence in a northeasterly direction across the highway into Section 11, all in Township 21 North, Range 13 East, thereby crossing the East and West Section line highway between sections 15 and 10, Township 21 North, Range 13 East; and crossing the North and South section line highway between Sections 10 and 11, Township 21 North Range 13 East, together with any other public roads or highways that may be crossed by a gas pipe line laid in accordance with the blue print map of survey hereto attached and made a part hereof. This line known as "Line J-2, Part Relocation", an eight inch gas pipe line.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways, and will be constricted in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma, governing the same.

It is hereby ordered and adjudged by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
