Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a quit claim deed to Georgia P. Morris nee Bullette covering Lot 10 of Bullette Second Addition and Lot 17 of Bullette Third Addition, both additions to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for reason that said property was sold in error; said property being non-taxable for the reason that said property is a part of the original homestead allotment of Georgia P. Bullette. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a quit claim deed to Levanna E. Bragg covering Lot 11, Block 8, Elm Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the reason that said property was sold to Tulsa County in error; said taxes having been paid prior to the date of the resale. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a quit claim deed to B. B. Shepard covering Lot 9, Block 4, McLane Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the reason that said property was sold in error to Tulsa County; said taxes having been paid prior to the date of the resale. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the action of the Board of County Commissioners on April 15th, 1939, approving an affidavit of erroneous assessment of C. E. Baldwin for the years 1931 to 1933, Inc., be and the same is hereby rescinded and the affidavit is hereby ordered cancelled for the reason that said taxes were paid on March 17th, 1939, therefore, the County Commissioners have no authority to reduce the assessment. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the application for re-assessment filed by Nellie P. Baldwin covering property for the years 1930 to 1936, inc., be and the same is hereby denied. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
