Commissioners upon roll call voting "yes" for the adoption of said Resolution, the same was
hereby resolved and approved as follows:

That the protest filed by the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad Company,
with reference to its percentage and amount of assessment for the expense of cleaning and re-
pairing drainage ditch in Park View Drainage District No. 2, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and
the same is hereby sustained, and the correct amount of its assessment and percentage of cost
of said cleaning be and the same is hereby fixed as follows:

Its property located in Section 4, Township 19N, Range 12E, Tulsa County, Oklahoma,
shall and is hereby fixed at two tenths of one per cent, making the amount of the
assessment against its property therein \$16.00, and

Its assessment against its property in Section 3, Township 19N, Range 12E., Tulsa
County, Oklahoma, shall and hereby is fixed at one per cent, making the amount of its
assessment therein \$80.00.

The percentage herein are with reference to the costs of the cleaning out and repairing
said ditch, which has heretofore been fixed at \$8,000.00.
