

R E S O L U T I O N .

The following resolution was introduced and read before the Board of Commissioners:-

WHEREAS, until the said Board has obtained for the County Assessor a certificate showing the assessed valuation of the County for the year 1920-1921 in order that it may determine the amount of revenue that can legally be raised in the General Fund for current expense purposes, and

WHEREAS, before the Board can approve and allow claims for charges not fixed by law, it is deemed advisable not to allow any claim other than those filed by law, and

WHEREAS, under the law of the State of Oklahoma the power and authority for contracting for supplies of every character is fixed in this Board.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that until appropriations are determined upon and allowed by the Excise Board no claim will be allowed by this Board nor warrants issued in payments thereof, excepting for salaries as fixed by law, and such fixed charges as are by law provided; And be it further resolved that this Board will not now nor in the future allow and pay any claim for supplies of every kind and character, the purchase of which has not been authorized by this Board.

RESOLUTION FOR THE SALE OF UNUSED PUBLIC LANDS
