Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the petition filed by the City of Tulsa in which it is asked that the Board of County Commissioners cancel taxes upon real estate now owned by the City of Tulsa which were assessed before the City acquired the property, be and the same is hereby denied. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the bid of \$17.50 made by L. V. Grater for an old 51 White Truck owned by Tulsa County, be and the same is hereby rejected. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the bid of \$35.00 made by George G. Black for pipe at the County Farm, be and the same is hereby rejected. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
