The Board of County Commissioners has this day received from the Board of Directors of the Agricultural and Industrial Exposition and Fair notification that said Board on April 30th, 1935, appointed H. E. Bridges as Secretary of said Board and requesting said Board of County Commissioners confirm said appointment; also notification that on the 7th day of May, 1935, the said Board of Directors had upon motion duly made and seconded fixed the salary of said Secretary at \$300.00 per month with 5¢ per mile for transportation, and expenses, when authorized by the Board, outside of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and providing that said Secretary shall have his house rent free, the administration building at the fair grounds, with lights, water and gas, and that his term of office shall not be in excess of one year;

The Board of County Commissioners has considered said communications and being fully advised in the premises, it was moved by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the appointment of H. E. Bridges as Secretary of said Board of Directors of the Agricultural and Industrial Exposition and Fair, be and the same is hereby confirmed and approved, and that his salary of \$300.00 per month with 5¢ per mile for transportation, and expenses, when authorized by the Board, outside of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and free house rent in the administration building at the fair grounds with lights, water and gas, and the term of office of said Secretary not to exceed one year, be and the same are hereby confirmed and approved. Upon roll call, the following votes were taken: Miller, Yes; Gray, Yes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the following communication be sent to Mr. M. H. Wise, present custodian of the buildings and grounds at the fair grounds, and tenant now occupying the administration building.
