#### ORDER OF PETITION.

Now, On this 4th. day of May, 1925, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, being in regular session, the matter of granting an easement and franchise of certain petitioner petitioning for the granting of the privilege of constructing a number of telephone lines along a portion of the Public highway, said petition being in writing and signed by E R Wells, Proprietor. The Board being fully advised in the premises, finds that the prayer of said Petitioner should be allowed and it is so ordered that an easement and franchise be granted by said Board to said Petitioner permitting him to construct and operate and maintain a number of telephone lines along the portion of public highways as follows:

Beginning at a point in the public highways near the north line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, Tp. 19 N., R 12 E., on the West Boundary line of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, thence running West on South side of the Public Highway to a point on the South side of said Highway near the NW corner of Lot 3, of Section 3, Tp 19 N., R 12 E., a distance of approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile along the public highway, all in Tulsa County, Okla.

The poles and wires of said lines to be located by the County Engineer of Tulsa County and so as not to interfere with the full use of the highways by the public and so as not to interfere with the working of or repairing said highways. Also so as not to interfere with the rights of property owners along that portion of the public highways traversed by said telephone lines, leaving unobstructed by wires or poles all ways of ingress or egress.

#### ORDER OF PETITION.

NOW, On this 4th. day of May, 1925, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, being in regular session, the matter of granting an easement and franchise of certain petitioners petitioning for the granting of the privilege of constructing a pipe line for water along a portion of the public highway, said petition being in writing and signed by E R WELLS, Proprietor. The Board being fully advised in the premises finds that the prayer of said Petitioner should be allowed and it is so ordered that an easement and franchise be granted by said Board to said petitioner permitting him to construct and operate and maintain a pipe line for water along the portion of public highways, as follows:

Beginning at a point in the public highways near the north line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, Twp. 19 N. R 12 E., where the West boundary line of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, intersects with the highway, extending West from West Easton Street at aforesaid city boundary, thence running West along the South Side of the public highway a distance of approximately  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles to the NW Corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Twp. 19 N., R 12 E., in all a distance of  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles along the public highways, all in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
