Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted Cash Fund in the amount of \$3,329.14, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County High-way Cash Fund in the amount of \$19,616.21, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, to approve the resignation of <u>C. L. Rains</u>, Deputy Sheriff, effective March 31, 1944. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, to approve the appointment of E. E. Sturgeon, as Deputy Sheriff, to replace C. L. Rains, at a salary of \$175.00 per month, effective April 1, 1944. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
