MONDAY, MAY 20th, 1935.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, May 20th, 1935, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Chairman Miller presiding, the following business was transacted:

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved:

The hearing on the affidavit of erroneous assessment of the Sand Springs Home was postponed until Monday, May 27th, 1935.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a recess is hereby taken until 2:00 o'clock P.M.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, The Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., with all members present and presiding as before.

Motion was made by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the written resignation of J. H. Bolton as Constable in District No. 10, Jenks, Oklahoma, be accepted as of May 20th, 1935. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

It appearing to the Board of County Commissioners that a vacancy exists in the office of Constable in District No. 10, Jenks, Oklahoma, a motion was made by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that J. G. Peters be and he is hereby appointed Constable in said District, subject to the filing of a official bond as provided by law. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the official bond of J. G. Peters as Constable in District No. 10, Jenks, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby approved and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the monthly report of E. A. Watterfield be accepted and filed. Motion carried.
