In the matter of the awarding of bids for the construction of Dormitories at the County Farm, upon motion of W L North, seconded by Ed W Hedgecock, the award is hereby made to Geo. O. Hollow Company for the sum of \$2,640.00.

Two bids were filed for the construction of an addition to School House in District No. 69. One of DUKE BROS, in the amount of \$2,245.78 and one of W E Pray in the amount of \$2,700.00. And, for District No. 1, DUKE BROS bid of \$2,512.90 and that of Mr. W E Pray being for \$2,745.00. Upon motion of Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, the award for both buildings was made to DUKE BROS. they being the lowest and best bidder therefor.

A J BOOKOUT'S bid of Eighty (\$80.00) for the purchase of School House near Keystone was accepted.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, that the County Attorney be authorized to take the necessary steps to sell confiscated cars captured by the Highway Police Department. Carried.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, that the report of Chas. Brown, J P be referred to County Attorney with instructions to bring such necessary legal proceedings against the said Justice of the Peace as to compel him to comply with the law, and if this cannot be done, then to proceed with an action to remove him from office.

In the matter of the Petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay pipe line along, under and across certain Highways of the County and State, the following order was made:

#### O R D E R

NOW, On this the 17th. day of October, 1927, the matter of the petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Proposed six inch gas pipe line on the West Side of Section line highway between Sections 19 and 20, Twp 19 N., Rge. 13 E., from the North line thereof running South approximately three-fourths mile.

Proposed six inch gas pipe line on the North side of Section line highway between Sections 19 and 30, Twp 19 N. m Rge 13 E., from West line thereof running thence East approximately three-fourths mile.
