And Now, on this 6th day of May, 1912, the application filed on the 20th day of April, 1912, praying for a hearing and order in the matter of said application coming on for hearing; and the County Commissioners of Tulsa County having examined the application, survey, map and census, and having heard proof by affidavit, and the said Board being satisfied that the requirements of law have been fully complied with:

IT IS ORDERED, that the territory described in said application, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter (1) of the Northwest Quarter (1), the Southwest (1) Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (1), the West Half (1) of the Southeast Quarter (1), except the M. K. & T. R. R. Co. Right of Way, the East Half (1) of the Southwest Quarter (1), except the M.K.&.T.E.R.Co., Right of Way, also a strip of ground One Hundred and twenty (120) feet wide off the South side of the Northeast Quarter (1) of the Northwest Quarter (1), and a strip of ground One Hundred and twenty (120) feet wide off the South side of the Northwest Quarter (1) of the Northeast Quarter (1), all of the above described property being in Section Eleven (11), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East, and containing 241.17 agres, exclusive of right of way of M. K. & T. R. R. Company:

shall, with the assent of the qualified voters thereof, as specified by law, be an incorporated town by the name of Sand Springs, as prayed for in said application.

And IT IS ORDERED that a notice be given for a meeting of the qualified voters resident in said proposed town, to be held atSand Springs townsite office in Kingsbury Building, a convenient place named by the Board, on the 21st day of May, 1912, to determine whether said territory shall be an incorporated town.

And, IT IS ORDERED that ten (10) days' notice of such meeting shall be given by publication in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper published in Tulsa County, and by posting up copies of said notice, not less than ten (10) in number, at the most public places in said proposed incorporated town.
