Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the application to correct excessive assessment filed by W. T. Maltby covering the W. 35' of the E. 70' of Lot 5, Block 133, O.T., Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the years 1930 to 1935, inc., be and the same is hereby approved as follows: The assessed valuation for the year 1930 reduced to \$6,000; 1931 reduced to \$6,000; 1932 reduced to \$5,000; 1933 reduced to \$4,000; 1934 reduced to \$4,000, and 1935 reduced to \$4,000, and we direct to the County Clerk to issue a Certificate of Error directing the County Treasurer to cancel the taxes and to issue a Certificate of Assessment re-assessing the within property, provided, however, that the Certificate of Error and the Certificate of Assessment re-assessing said property shall not be issued until the expiration of ten (10) days from the date of this order and, provided, further, that said Certificate of Assessment shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said ten day period until the issued of said protest be determined. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the application for correction of erroneous assessment filed by the Peerless Realty and Operating Company covering Reserves A and B of Park Addition to Red Fork, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the years 1930 to 1935, inc., be and the assessed valuation is hereby reduced to \$10,000 for each year, and the County Clerk is directed to issue a Certificate of Error directing the County Treasurer to cancel the taxes and to issue a Certificate of Assessment re-assessing the within property, provided, however, that the Certificate of Error and the Certificate of Assessment re-assessing said property shall not be issued until the expiration of ten days from the date of this order and, provided further, that said Certificate of Assessment shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said ten day period until the issues of said protest be determined.
