BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Highway Commission of Oklahoma is hereby requested to submit said plans, specifications, and estimates to the Public Roads Administration for approval and participation, and when the approval of the Public Roads Administration is received, that the Highway Commission of Oklahoma is hereby requested to proceed with the advertising, opening of bids and other formalities in accordance with the usual procedure in letting of contracts for State Highway Construction.

Be it remembered that at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioner of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, held at the Courthouse in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 5th day of August, 1946, the following resolution was unanimously adopted by said Board of County Commissioners, to-wit:
