"It is the opinion of the Attorney General that any surplus balance remaining in the "County Emergency Fund" and the moneys to accrue to that fund on account of warrants or judgments as an investment for that fund, should be placed in the "County Highway Fund..... and that after the surplus balance remaining in the "County Emergency Investment Fund" has been transferred by the Board of County Commissioners into the "County Highway Fund", and that said money is subject to be used this fiscal year by supplemental appropriation".

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that any surplus balance remaining in the "County Emergency Investment Fund" is hereby transferred to the "County Highway Fund", and the County Treasurer is directed to enter said transfer on his books.
