To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

Comes now C. M. Tubbs of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and respectfully petitions the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa, County, Oklahoma, as followsL

That your petitioner desires to place in operation a rural telephone line extending out of the city of Tulsa from the place of beginning near the intersection of North Lewis Avenue with the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, and extending North on the east side of Lewis Avenue for a distance of about one mile, with three branch lines, the first branch beginning at a point about one fourth mile from place of beginning and extending east along the north side of the quarter section line for about three blocks, the second branch commencing at a point about one half mile from the place of beginning and extending west along the north side of the section line for about two blocks, and a third branch beginning at a point about one mile forn the place of beginning and extending west about two blocks.

Your petitioner further states that he has made a contract with the Bell Telephone Company of this City permitting him to connect to their line at the city limits.

That your petitioner further states that the operation of said line will in no way effect the right of the public to travel said section lines, and that said tekephone line will serve about ten (10) rural subscribers. It is understood that should it become necessary to remove said line and poles for the purpose of widening or otherwise improving the toad, your petitioner agrees to do same without expense to the county of Tulsa.
