Gentlemen:

Your petitioner respectfully requests that the County of Tulsa give a right of way grant or easement for the purpose of laying, constructing and maintaining a two inch water main, over, under and across the following described lands belonging to Tulsa County, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 4,
Section Nineteen (19), Range Twenty (20), North,
Range Thirteen (13) East, and running North
along the East Line of the North Peoria Avenue
Road Right of Way a distance of 2100 feet to the
Spavinaw High Pressure Water Line.

Said water line to be laid below the road surface to be determined by the Tulsa County Engineer; said water line to be maintained at the expense of the said petitioner and all repairs thereon to be made without damage to the road or the lands herein described; that the petitioner will put the surface of the said land back in as good condition as it now is after said water line has been laid.

As a further condition the petitioner will move the said water line off the premises of the said Tulsa County upon thirty days notice, in writing, to it if at any time the said Tulsa County, or its assigns, deem it necessary to have the said premises free of said water line.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioner respectfully asks that the said Tulsa County make a right of way grant or easement to this Petitioner upon the conditions herein stated and for the purposes set out.
