Motion was made by F.M.Wooden, seconded by Ira Short, that the Section Lines between Sections 28 and 33, Twp. 19, N., R. 12, East, from the east line of said Sections be opened for highway purposes and that the County Clerk be authorized to ask the State Corporation Commission to order the Oklahoma Union Railway Company to open the same over their tracks and right of way. The following vote was had: Geo.E.Gilmore, Yes, F.M.Wooden, Yes and Ira Short, Yes. Motion was declared carried.

The following resolution was introduced by Geo.E.Gilmore, who moved its adoption. The same was seconded by F.M.Wooden, and upon roll call was unanimously carried.

WHEREAS, An Emergency seeming to exist whereby it is required that for the safety and protection to life and property, that a drainage opening be constructed to replace an old dilapidated wooden bridge located on the North Line of the South Half of the South Half of Section 3, Township 19, North, Range 10 East.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Engineer be instructed to proceed to have constructed in lieu thereof, a permanent opening of such size as is necessary to properly carry the drainage, and authority is hereby given to extend the contract of A.C. Bancroft as awarded on the 7th. day of August, 1922, as is provided for in said contract to include the above culvert.
