

A. Watson's Court. Motion carried.

In the matter of the Petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company for permission to lay pipe lines along certain of Tulsa County's Highways, the following Order was made:

# O R D E R

Now, on this 18th. day of May, 1925, the matter of the Petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Company, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 2370 feet West and approximately 20 feet North of the Southeast Corner of Section 9, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and running thence West a distance of 8360 feet to a point within the Southeast corner of Section 7, Township 19 North, Range 12 East; thereby paralleling the East and West Section line highway between Sections 9, 16, 8 and 17; and crossing the North extension (or branch) of above mentioned highway which is at a point near the center of the South line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8, Twp 19 N., Rge. 12 East as per blue print plat hereto attached and made a part hereof. This line to be known as "Service Lines-City of Tulsa-to Zenith Limestone Company, a four inch gas pipe line

And it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.

## ORDER ALLOWING LAYING OF PIPE LINES ALONG AND ACROSS THE PUBLIC HIGHWAY

NOW, On this 18th. day of May, 1925, the Sapulpa Refining Company having filed its application requesting permission from the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County to install, maintain and operate along and across the public highway

extending South from the Northeast corner of Section 4, 19 North, 12 East, along the East line of Section 4, 9, to the Southeast corner of Section 9, thence East along the South line of Section 10, to the Southeast corner of 10, thence South to the southeast corner of section 22, thence Southwest to the Southwest corner of Section 33, 19 North 12 East, with a connecting line commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 4, 19 North, 12 East, extending West along the North side of the Sand Springs Railway Company's right of way crossing, section line roads
