Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the applications for re-assessment of unpaid ad valorem tax filed by A. J. Spahr for the Right Way Laundry covering personal and realestate for the years 1931 to 1935, inc., be and the same is hereby approved as submitted to the Board. Application No. 35409. The County Clerk is hereby directed to issue Certificates of Error directing the County Treasurer to cancel the taxes and to issue Certificates of Assessment re-assessing the within property, provided, however, that the Certificates of Error and the Certificates of Assessment re-assessing said property shall not be issued until the expiration of ten days from the date of this order and provided further that said Certificates of Assessment shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said ten day period until the issued of said protest be determined.
