Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that hospitalization be allowed only in cases of emergencies and the three larger hospitals, namely: Morningside, St. Johns and Tulsa General be allowed \$600.00 each per month and the Flower Hospital \$150.00 and the City Hospital at Sand Springs \$50.00 per month, and that the hospitals be notified that if they exceed said amounts the County Commissioners will refuse to pay it. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sallee, and upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried. Said motion effective April 10th.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that a recess be taken until Saturday, April 6th, 1940, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
